Yes! There is **no membership fee** or business license requirement. **The Philadelphia Wholesale Produce Market is open to the public.** Unlike many terminal markets around the country, the PWPM was designed to serve many populations. We **welcome a variety of customers** ranging from large supermarket chains to home chefs. We also **proudly embrace neighborhood coop groups** who buy in bulk in order to cut costs and increase access to fresh, healthy produce. We are honored to share the abundance of our state-of-the-art facility with everyone in the greater Philadelphia region.

Some things to keep in mind:

Produce is purchased in bulk - by the case or carton.

Bring a jacket – the Market is kept at about 50 degrees.

Bring your walking shoes - the concourse is ¼ mile long.

It's a good idea to bring a hand truck if you plan on buying more than one case.

Cash is king, although some of our 21 merchants accept credit cards.

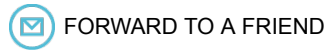
