#### Philabundance Produce Rescue

For the past year and a half, **Philabundance**, the Delaware Valley's largest hunger relief organization, has set up a *Produce Rescue Center* on Friday mornings in a breezeway of the 686,000 square foot Philadelphia Wholesale **Produce Market (PWPM).** What started as a seed of an idea has blossomed into a successful long-term program that has collected well over 1,000,000 lbs. of fresh produce, feeding people in nine counties in PA and South Jersey.

"The process is pretty simple," says Christine Hofmann, Marketing Coordinator for the PWPM. "Philabundance sends a reminder to the merchants each week about the Rescue Center and visits the stores to inspect and approve pallets for donation. Fridays are a particularly good day for donations since the PWPM is closed on Saturdays."

Philabundance brings in volunteers from Philly area companies to sort through the cases to get them to 100% high-quality produce. "The volunteers are invaluable," says Tana Wilkinson, Food Acquisition Procurement Associate at Philabundance, "Without their efforts and their time commitment, those cases would be wasted and our neighbors in need wouldn't have the benefit of this perfectly delicious produce."


